Curriculum Notes

Religion-Seventh grade will be hosting a special event during Catholic Schools Week called "A Parade of Saints." Each student will 'become' a saint and give a short, memorized speech. They students will dress like the saint and create a poster. The students have all selected a saint-ask your child what saint he/she has chosen. We read the Gospel to be prepared for Sunday Mass.
