### Curriculum Notes

**Religion**-We finished up chapter 7 discussing the different heresies about the incarnation. Through the heresy of arianism, we have the nicene creed we say at Mass on Sundays. We also worked on an acrostic to review the chapter and the humanity of Jesus. We will have our chapter test next week. Lastly, we read the Sunday Gospel. **Vocabulary**- We jumped back into our vocabulary book and worked on unit 14 (almost finished with the book!). We did a vocabulary jar check...7th grade now has more than 7.000 words!

**English**-We had an easier week in English after finishing our research papers. We used some of our English class periods to finish up our projects for the curriculum fair.

**Reading**-We are finishing the year in reading with a different 'format' for our last novel. I'm using a 'book club' type format. The students were given four books to choose from-each with an outdoor/nature kind of theme (along with self-survival,too). The students viewed a video for each book and listened to the first part of chapter one. The students selected a book and were grouped according to their choice. They will be reading the book with each other and working on a sketch book and journal prompts throughout the novel. Ask them what book they selected!

**Science**-We started a new chapter-earthquakes and volcanoes. We used cheese and crackers to demonstrate the three different kinds of faults and forces of earthquakes.
