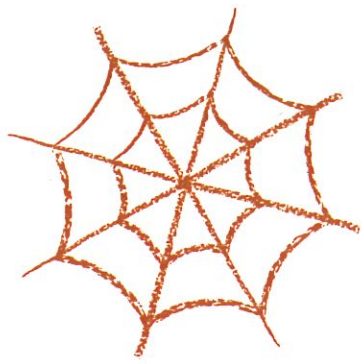

We gladly accept cash, checks, and all major credit cards. Please note that we do not ask for, nor do we accept, any donations

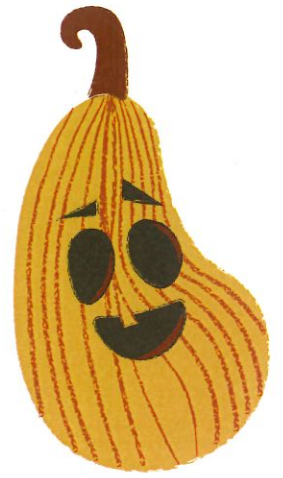

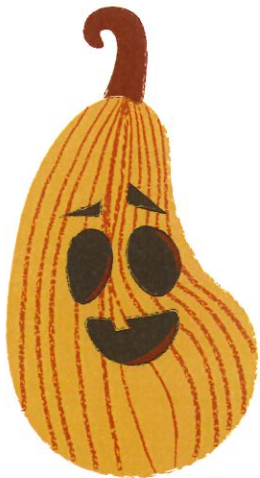
