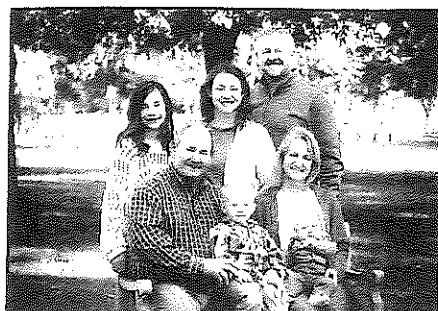
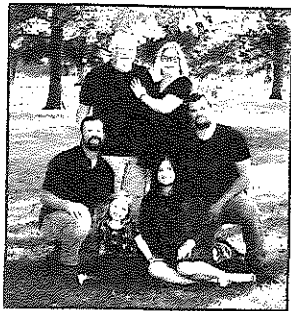
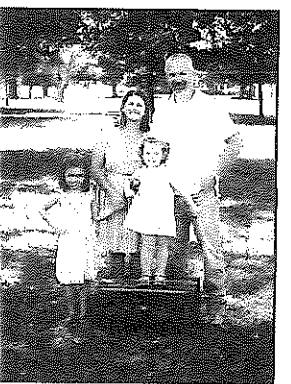
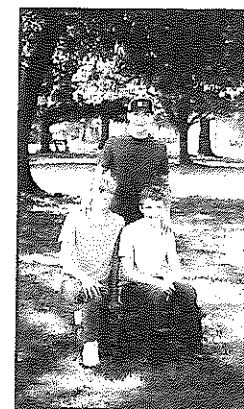
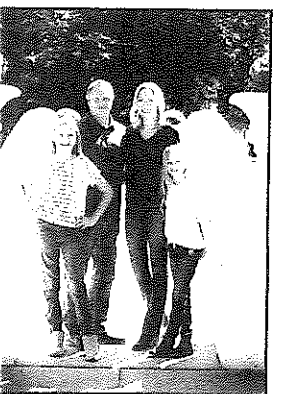
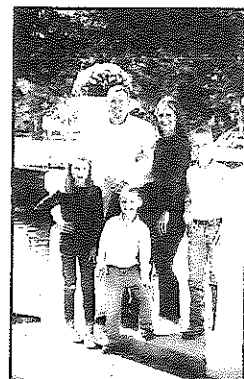


Photo Fundraiser
