Curriculum Notes

Religion-We reviewed chapter 7 using the study guide, and the chapter test was Wednesday. We were not able to read the Sunday Gospel because the students left right at 8 a.m. so we did not have any class time. Next chapter-Mary.

Vocabulary- We finished unit 14 and started in on the LAST unit. We also did a vocab jar check. 7, 569 words and counting!

English-We worked on poetry this week. The students wrote a 'found' poem using their research paper. They 'found' the key words and phrases from their paper, wrote them on notecards, organized them into a poem. Next, they created the poem in Google drawing adding images and designs. We also worked on different sentences. For example, sentences with compound subjects and verbs along with complex sentences.

Reading-Students seem to be enjoying the 'book club' format we are using for our last novel. Students are reading together and then working in their sketchbooks to show understanding. We also reviewed literary terms using a Kahoot.

Science-We discussed faults and forces of earthquakes, waves, epicenter, and focus. We used playdough to create the three different kind of faults.
