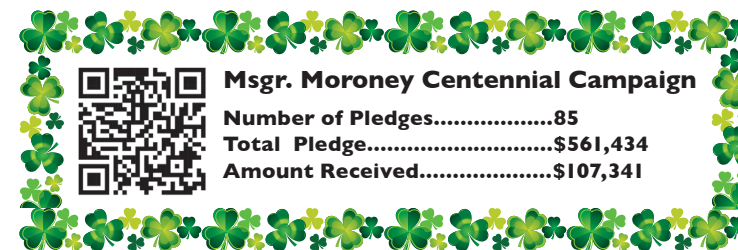

There you will find forms for both new and returning preschool students. Then visit Chrissy Nollman at the parish office (phone: 562-5396) for information on tuition, as well as to submit the tuition forms, \$50 book fee, and a \$25 auction basket fee. Next, please register with Sam Jostes at the school office. By the first day of school, you will need to provide the following documents: 1) a copy of your child's birth certificate, 2) a physical examination record, 3) a copy of immunizations, and 4) a copy of lead screening results.
