SACRED HEART PRE-SCHOOL REGISTRATION FOR 2026-2027

Pre-school registration will take place on Thursday, April 9 and Friday, April 10 from 7:30 AM to 4:00 PM. To begin the registration process, please visit the website (shspana.com) and under the “Parents” tab click on registration. There you will find forms for both new and returning preschool students. Then visit Chrisy Nollman at the parish office (phone: 562-5396) for information on tuition, as well as to submit the tuition forms, \$50 book fee, and a \$25 auction basket fee. Next, please register with Sam Jostes at the school office.

By the first day of school, you will need to provide the following documents: 1) a copy of your child's birth certificate, 2) a physical examination record, 3) a copy of immunizations, and 4) a copy of lead screening results. If your child attended preschool with us last year, these documents are already on file and do not need to be resubmitted.
