Ecumenical Thanksgiving Prayer & Fellowship Sunday, November 19 – 5:00 p.m. First United Methodist Church

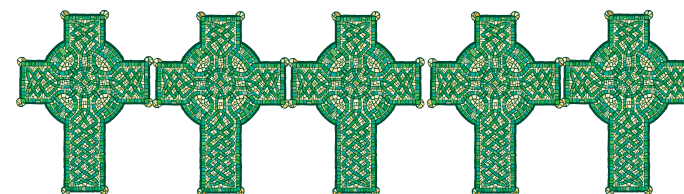

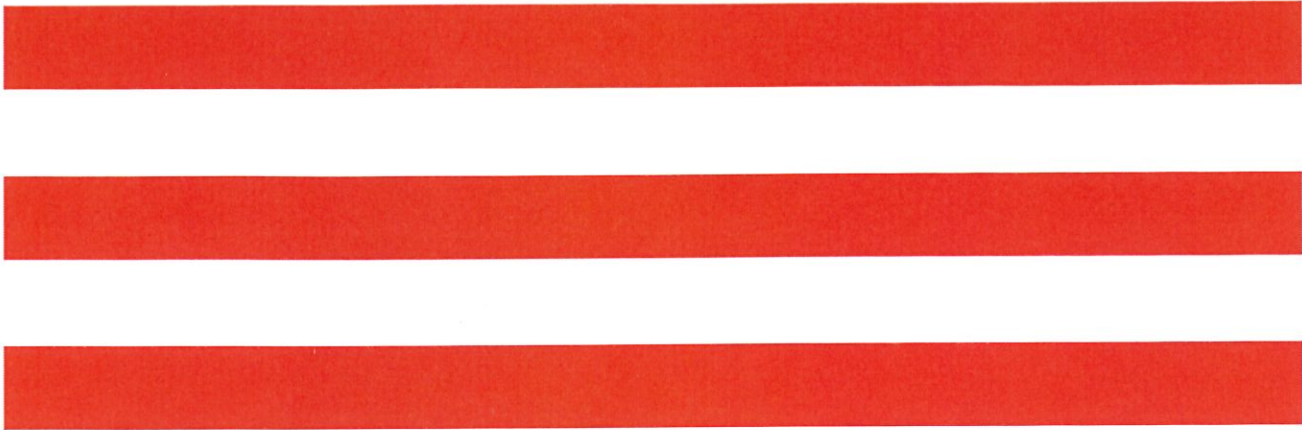
