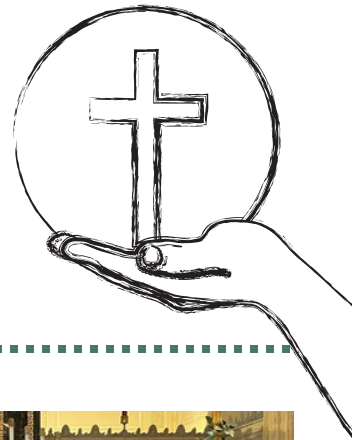


## FIRST RECONCILIATION

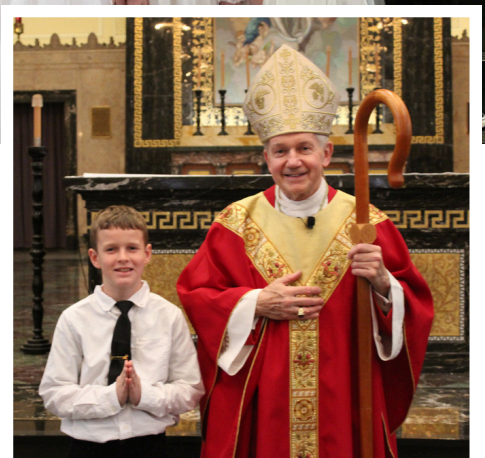


## FIRST COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION
