Letters will precede numbers and there must be a space between letters and numbers. (Examples: SHS 4, BBALL , 1988, GO 15). Feel free to get creative!

Orders for personalized plates must be received no later than September 11, 2026 and cannot be accepted after this date. Payment will be due with order forms. No changes or corrections can be made after personalized orders are submitted to S.O.S. Be sure you have the correct spelling and numbers before you place your order!!!

Order forms will also be available on our website!

*Preference will be given on a first-come, first-served basis as order forms and payment are received. We will be ordering a minimum of 50 sets of plates this year, so a limited quantity of numbered plates **may** be available for general purchase in December.*

Please complete a separate form for each set of plates requested. Return completed forms and payment to Mrs. Siegert through the school or parish offices. You may also drop orders in the collection basket at weekend Masses. Please contact Sheila by email (ssiegert@shspana.org) with questions. You **must** provide a photocopy of your entire vehicle registration form to Sheila prior to receiving the plates in December. The registration must be current through January 31, 2027. If your registration expires between December 2026 and January 2027, it must be renewed and proof of renewal provided to Sheila prior to receiving the plates. This is a Secretary of State requirement.

The following Illinois Secretary of State guidelines must be met for special event plates: Plates may be displayed on passenger vehicles and B-trucks. The vehicle must be currently registered in Illinois. Registrations that expire December 2026 through January 2027 must be renewed before special event plates can be issued. All registration information will be verified by the Secretary of State and your order will be nullified if incomplete or incorrect information is provided.
