Curriculum Notes

Religion-We took the test over chapter 4- God's plan for Salvation. We started a new chapter as we move ahead a bit in the book-Chapter 7- Our Lord & Savior, Jesus Christ. We responded to a bible quote and worked on vocabulary. As always-we read the Sunday gospel. We discussed the verse "Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her." John 8:1-11.

Vocabulary-We stepped away from our vocabulary book and worked on research papers. The students did very well using their extra research time. We did a vocab jar check. We are over 6,000 words now!

English-The students worked on their research papers. Many have finished with their first source and have even started on their second. Please check in with your child periodically to see how the research is going.

Reading-We finished nine chapters in *Roll of Thunder Hear my Cry*. We finished our comprehension pages and discussed equity and equality with a visual representation. The plan is to finish the novel next week.

Science-We finished chapter 12 and took the assessment this week. We started on our dodecahedron biome ball. The plan is for you to see them at the curriculum fair later this month.
