Dear Parish Family,

We have much to be thankful for at St. Patrick's Church. Our parish has a rich history of worship, prayer, evangelization, service, and community for over 170 years. Our welcoming campus is a place where we live the intense presence of God and many of life's most important experiences, whether it be through the Mass or other sacraments, our faith formation programs, the parish school, or our diverse ministries. It is such a blessing to be your pastor and witness each day how our community of missionary disciples lives out the Church's mission.

Our church building provides us with a noble place to offer God our praise and worship as Christ has lovingly taught us. We do so with using the gifts given to us through the Holy Spirit. The maintenance of our facilities is necessary for us to provide a dignified, comfortable space for the celebration of the sacraments. However, we have all noticed the toll taken on our 100-year old church by time and the elements. Necessary and critical work includes: plastering; painting; climate control through HVAC additions; repair of pews; and care of our terrazzo floor.

For these reasons and after thorough discernment and consultation, we are embarking on a capital campaign to raise \$975,000. This would allow us to preserve and maintain our beautiful church.

The enclosed brochure shares the necessary plans to ensure that we raise the funds necessary to maintain God's house and continue to grow God's Kingdom here at St. Patrick's Church. Whether you are new to St. Patrick's Church or have been here from the beginning, I ask you to prayerfully reflect on how you have been blessed by this parish. I invite you to prayerfully consider how you are able to contribute your financial gifts to this crucial effort for our parish and join with me in praying for the success of our campaign. Sacrificial giving is an expression of our faith and a way to put our faith into action.

The Suggested Gift Chart details pledges ranging from \$1,620 to \$25,000 payable over 3 years. That is a little as only one dollar and a half per day over 36 months. This wide range of gift opportunities makes it possible for virtually every family to take part in the program.

Time will be set aside during all Masses on the weekend of March 14th and 15th for the faithful of St. Patrick's Church to make your pledge. Please bring your completed card, or be prepared to complete a pledge card at Mass.

Thank you for your prayerful consideration and generous support for our parish as we look to the future with hope and continue to build the Kingdom of God.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. When will the work begin?

A. The work will begin as the funds become available from the Capital Campaign.

Q. What will happen if we go over our goal?

A. All gifts collected after we exceed our goal will be put towards the maintenance and upkeep of our facilities.

Q. Can I fulfill my pledge online?

A. Yes, you can set up your pledge payments using our Online Giving Platform.

Q. Why should I make a pledge?

A. Most people take advantage of time-payments for major purchases. A pledge to the parish Capital Campaign is a "time-payment plan" that makes it possible for you to meet your parish obligations without undue hardship. Pledges enable you to consider a more significant contribution to the campaign rather than a one-time gift.

Q. Is my pledge over and above my Sunday Offering?

A. Yes. We can only reach our goal with a little extra sacrifice. We cannot reach our goal if we reduce our weekly offerings in order to make a pledge to the Capital Campaign. The parish will continue to have normal operating expenses during the pledge period.

Q. Who will be asked to support the Campaign?

A. Every parish family will be invited to be a part of this effort. It is our hope that every parish family will make a sacrificial gift for this major effort according to his or her financial ability. We hope everyone will play a conscientious role in renewing the future of the parish.

Q. What happens if I cannot fulfill my pledge?

A. Pledges are made in good faith and accepted as such. If hardship or illness prevents you from fulfilling your pledge, let the parish know, and other arrangements will be made.

Q. What if I would like to give stocks, real estate or some other kind of gift?

A. There are several ways to support our campaign, please see the ways to give section on the next pages of this brochure or call the parish office.
