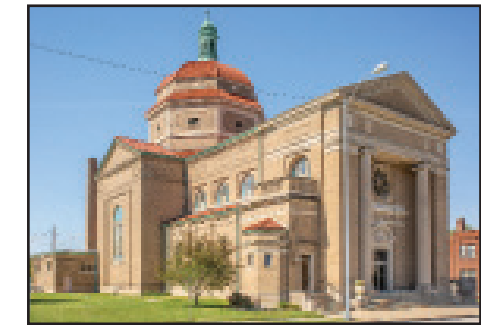

REMINDERS:

TUITION PRE-REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED WITH CHRISY BEFORE SCHOOL REGISTRATION IS ALLOWED.

It is mandatory for Kindergarten, 2nd and 6th graders to have a dental exam or a signed waiver. Kindergarten students should have an eye exam by a licensed optometrist or a signed waiver and a 2nd Varicella vaccine. Students entering 6th grade should have proof of having a T-Dap vaccine, 2nd Varicella injection, and a meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV). Students entering Kindergarten, 6th grade, or anyone playing 7-8th grade sports should have a physical exam. Please mark your calendars, as this date and time are very important.
